



Dear Parents and Carers,

Another busy week this week - the children have enjoyed designing their Supertato model, starting their WANTED posters for Evil Pea, ordered events in their day and enjoyed the lovely sunshine in the outside classroom!

Phonics - This week we will continue to review all the sounds learned so far. We will also be learning the following HRSWs: *children, love* and reviewing the others we have learned this half term. Please practise these at home.

Literacy - In Literacy we will continue to focus on 'Supertato' and writing our WANTED posters focussing on Evil Pea and his actions and behaviours.

Maths - We will be exploring the numbers 9 and 10. The children will be finding ways to make the amounts in different ways. They will also be comparing numbers to 10 using dominoes and similar resources.

Understanding the World - Our small world area will be focussing on signs of spring and Easter. The children will be going on a hunt for signs of spring in the outdoor classroom and bringing them into the classroom to explore. We will be encouraging the children to add their own labels and signs to a spring themed imaginary small world.

Fine Motor - This week we will be using a range of loose parts and natural materials to recreate artwork in the style of Andy Goldsworthy in the theme of eggs for Easter.

Please note: This week we will be carrying out phonics assessments on the children, so we won't be reading individually with each child.
