### *'Let's Celebrate!'*

### Creative Development:

- Learning Nativity songs with actions
- Learning and singing nursery rhymes with actions
- Playing simple percussion instruments to play alongside Nativity songs
- Make Christmas decorations
- Listen to and compare Christmas songs from around the world
- Artist focus: Kandinsky – printing circles and triangles
- Junk modelling – encouraging pupils to design for making
- Printing, painting, modelling, pastels

### Physical Development:

- Developing throwing, catching, rolling and travelling skills
- Developing large motor skills using indoor and outdoor apparatus
- Outdoor activities including dancing in the stage area, using bikes and scooters, climbing and obstacle courses
- Developing fine motor skills, threading, construction etc.
- Developing fine motor control through finger gym activities and malleable activities
- Learning and joining in with simple dance routines for the Nativity
- Practise forming letters

### Literacy:

- Essential Letters and Sounds – Revise Phase 2 & introduce Phase 3
- Harder to Read and Spell word recognition – Revise Phase 2 & introduce Phase 3
- Explore rhyme and the alphabet
- Continue developing pencil grip and control
- Hear and write the initial, end and some middle sounds in words
- Form lower case letters correctly

### Understanding the World:

- Continue daily weather and season charts
- Exploring the weather outside and leave items to freeze and melt observing the processes
- Learn about Remembrance Day
- Learn about the celebration of Diwali
- Make links and compare to Christmas – invite families to share how they celebrate Christmas, learn about different celebrations within this country and around the world
