Dear Parents/Carers,

English - This week the children will be learning an animated story called 'Something Fishy' and narrating it in their own words.

Maths - In maths the children will be continuing to learn about fractions. They will be learning to recognise and find quarters and thirds.

D&T - In DT the children will be investigating a variety of vehicles and their uses and features.

Computing - In computing the children will be exploring the new tool 2Paint.

Geography - The children will be recalling the names and location of the seven continents and oceans.

Science - The children will be comparing the similarities and differences between bulbs and seeds.

RE and World Views - In RE the children will be learning about Judaism and what Jewish people do to celebrate the gift of Shabbat.

PSHE - This week the children will identify the different members of their family and understand their relationship with each of them. They will discover that everyone's family is different and understand that most people value their family.
