

Week beginning: 20.04.2026



Dear Parents/Carers,

**English** - This week the children will be beginning to explore fairy tales. They will be identifying features of fairy tales and sequencing and retelling a familiar story.

**Maths** - The children will be recognising unit and non-unit fractions as well as recognising the equivalence of a half and two quarters.

**D&T** - In D&T the children will be continuing their topic of making carriages. This week they will be investigating wheels, axis and chassis.

**Computing** - In computing the children will be looking at the work of pointillist artists such as Seurat and creating a pointillist style painting using 2Paint.

**Geography** - The children will be using globes, maps and atlases to locate South Africa and exploring human and physical features.

**Science** - The children will be identifying what plants need to grow, thrive and be healthy.

**RE and World Views** - In RE the children will be finding out why it is important for Jewish families to do something different during Shabbat.

**PSHE** - This week the children will be exploring different forms of physical contact within a family and that some of this is acceptable and some is not. They will be able to identify the types of physical contact they like and don't like and will be able to talk about this.

**Music** - In music the children will be listening to two songs and comparing them.

**Reading** - Please read with your child every night for 10 minutes and ask them questions about the book. Books will continue to be changed by the children on a Friday. Please also complete Numbots activities at home for Maths fluency.

**Forest school takes place on Thursdays. We would be very grateful if any parents could help with any of the sessions.**
