Dear Parents/Carers,

English - The children will be looking at alternative fairytales linked to Cinderella and innovating the story of Cinderella.

Maths - The children will be coming to the end of their learning on Fractions recognising and finding $\frac{3}{4}$'s and counting up to the whole.

D&T - The children will be designing their Cinderella inspired carriage.

Computing - The children will be looking at the work of William Morris and recreating a piece of work on 2Paint.

Geography - The children will be comparing physical and human features of Fish Hoek and Weybridge.

Science - The children will be planning to plant a bulb and a seed.
