

Week commencing 08.06.2026

English: - This week in English we are creating our own animal and writing a description about it using suffixes e.g. loudest, fluffiest etc.

Phonics: - The phonics screening check will be taking place this week and we will continue to recap the taught sounds with the children.

Maths: - We will be learning about ordinal numbers e.g. 1st, 2nd 3rd and will also be counting within 100 in 10s.

Science: - This week the children will look at fish and understand what makes an animal a fish.

PSHE: - The children will explore that changes happen as we grow and understand that this is OK.

P.E: - We will practise the events that we will be taking part in on Sports Day.

History: - We will be looking at Intrepid Explorers, beginning with looking at the voyage of Christopher Columbus and what he discovered.

Computing: - This week, the children will begin to understand that computer programs work by following instructions called code.

Art: - The children will look at the artist Julie Clements and explore her work. They will look at her sculpture work, discuss their likes and dislikes and think about why she chooses nature to inspire her work.
