

English:- This week we will be looking at the book 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne. The children will be getting familiar with the story, through drama activities and will be sequencing the story.

Phonics:- We are recapping all of the different alternative ways to say the 's', 'n', 'g' sounds.

Maths:- We will continue to be comparing numbers by finding one more and one less practically and pictorially. The children will then move on to comparing numbers with different amounts of 10s.

PSHE:- We will be discussing some things about us that have changed and some things about us that have stayed the same.

History:- We will be looking at Intrepid Explorers, beginning with looking at the voyage of Christopher Columbus and what he discovered.

RE:- We will be looking at the story of Esther and why it is important for Jewish people.

Computing:- This week, the children will use code to create a computer program and explore objects and actions.

Art:- The children will explore the shape, colour and texture of animal faces.

Science:- This week the children will explore what reptiles and amphibians are.

Music:- This week the children will listen to and appraise 'Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious' and compare it with 'Your Imagination'.
