

English: - For international week, we will be learning about the Bahamas! The children will be creating fact files, making their own coral reef and designing and describing their own carnival masks. **On Friday children can dress up in colours of the Bahamas Flag or in sensible carnival costumes for our Bahamas celebration.**
