

English: - This week the children will continue to use 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne to inspire their writing. They will look at the structure of the story, change the main characters and then re-write their own alternative version.

Phonics: - This week the children will look at alternative graphemes (different ways of spelling the same sound). They will learn:

/oo/ spelled o e.g. move, grove

/h/ spelled wh e.g. whole

/wh/ spelled u e.g. penguin

/ee/ spelled ei e.g. protein

Maths: - This week the children will begin to look at money. They will start by unitising (unitising means treating groups that contain or represent the same number of things as units or ones). After this they will move on to look at the different value of coins and notes.

Art: - We will be creating an animal sculpture using clay.

History: - We continue to learn about Neil Armstrong and the space race.

PSHE: We will be learning the parts of the body that make boys different to girls and can use the correct names for these: penis, testicles, vagina, vulva, anus.

Music: - This week the children will be playing instruments along to 'Your Imagination'.

Computing: - This week the children will explore coding using Bubble Coding on Purple Mash.

Science - We will be learning about omnivores, carnivores and herbivores are.

PE: We will continue working on our coordination skills, particularly sending and receiving different size balls.
