English - The children will be reading *The Rainbow Bear* by Michael Morpurgo. As well as making predictions and inferences the children will be developing their vocabulary and studying the author's techniques.

Maths - The children will be drawing and interpreting pictograms, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
