This week we will be celebrating International Week!

We will be learning about the fascinating country of Japan. The children will be finding out simple facts about Japan, focussing on impressive landmarks. They will be looking at the artwork of Yayoi Kusama and producing their own artwork inspired by her work. The children will also be completing exciting activities such as how to write a haiku poem, how to write their name in Japanese and learn some basic phrases. They will also learn a popular rhyme in Japanese and will have a go at origami!

Dear Parents/Carers,

English - The children will be learning the features of haiku poems and creating their own haiku poem.

Maths - The children will be continuing with their topic on position and direction, describing movement and turns.

Computing - The children will be learning that different objects have different attributes. They will be finding out what different events do in code.

Geography - The children will be learning about geographical features in Japan.

Science - The children will be discovering what wildlife does for us.

Art - The children will be creating a Yayoi Kusama inspired piece of art.

PE - The children will be developing and applying floor work in a range of games.

RE - The children will be exploring what people did in the past to show they care for the environment.

Music - The children will be rehearsing for 'Matilda'.

Reading - Please read with your child every night for 10 minutes and ask them questions about the book. Books will continue to be changed by the children on a Friday. Please also complete the Numbots activities at home for Maths fluency.
