

English: - The children will be picking an animal to focus on and will be researching information about that animal. They will then create an engaging poster full of facts about their chosen animal.

Phonics: - This week the children will look at some alternative graphemes. These will include:

/ee/ spelled i e.g. marina

/oa/ spelled ough e.g. dough

/or/ spelled our e.g. colour

/ur/ spelled re e.g. centre

Maths: - This week the children will begin to learn about time. We will initially think about things you do at different times of the day and sequence these. We will then move on to looking at the days of the week and months of the year, the order they come in, and which days come before and after each other.

Art: - The children will create their own clay sculptures this week using techniques they have practised.

History: - This week the children will be introduced to Sunita Williams and learn about some of the things that modern astronauts do.

Music: - The children will compose their own melodies and then try to play these over their new lyrics.

Science: - This week we will visit Marwell Zoo.

PSHE: - The children will think about how every time they learn something new they change a little bit.

RE: - We will think about all of the stories we have learnt about this term and what they have taught us.
