

Week commencing 14.09.2026

English: This week we will be re-capping the story 'Super Duper You' by Sophy Henn. We will be looking at some familiar superheroes and will be thinking about why they wear capes. We will then design and write about our own cape. We will also be writing captions to match the story.

Phonics: - We will be recapping the sounds learnt in reception and we will also be completing a phonics screening check.

Maths: - We will be counting objects from a large group (up to 10 objects) and recognising numbers as numeral and words.

Science: We will begin to learn about our senses and this week we will have a particular focus on the sense of hearing.

Music: - Listen and appraise the song 'Fresh Prince of Bel Air!' by Will Smith and find the pulse to the song 'Hey You'.

PSHE: - We will be talking about how we all belong to a class group (e.g. Squirrel Class) and about our roles and responsibility within the classroom.

Geography: - We will be talking about what we know already about the local area.

Art: - We will be exploring the work of Brianna McCarthy and different collage techniques.
