English - In English we will be sequencing the story 'Lost and Found' and retelling it in our own words.

Phonics - We will be reviewing some phonics sounds that we learned in Year 1.

Maths - We will be continuing with Place Value, partitioning numbers to 100 and writing numbers to 100 in words.

Geography - We will be naming and locating the four countries of the UK and their capital cities.

PSHE - We will be explaining our rights and responsibilities.

Computing - We will be learning how to open applications and how to save our work.

Art - We will be experimenting with different joining techniques which we will later use to make a sculpture.

Science - We will be learning to understand what fish and amphibians need to survive.
